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Biographical Note: Charles J. Stahl was born in the Germantown section of Philadelphia in 1930. The son of German-American parents, he moved to a small farm in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania at the age of 9, where he finished his primary and secondary education. Stahl first became interested in medicine through his exposure to first aid and other health and safety issues as a Boy Scout. He was the first Eagle Scout in Harleysville, Pennsylvania, and eventually became Assistant Scout Master and a merit badge counselor. In 1948, he began his pre-med studies at Ursinus College in Collegeville, Pennsylvania. After graduating in 1952, he was commissioned as an ensign in the Navy, the same year he began his studies at Jefferson Medical College. After marrying in 1954, Stahl went on active duty in 1955, his last year of medical school. He was promoted to Lieutenant Junior grade and became a Naval intern the following year. At the U.S. Naval Hospital in Philadelphia, from 1957 until 1961, Stahl specialized in anatomic and clinical pathology. At the same time he began taking short courses in continuing education at the AFIP, which bolstered his interest in forensic pathology.

In 1962, Stahl became the first formal resident in forensic pathology at the AFIP, and the first Navy officer to enter that field. Appointed as an approved pathologist for the State of Maryland at this time, he conducted autopsies in Montgomery County and Baltimore during off-duty hours. After finishing his residency, Stahl then spent two years in Guam as the Chief of Laboratory Service and Deputy Medical Examiner from 1963-1964. In 1965, he began his assignment as the Chief of Forensic Pathology at the AFIP, where he remained for the next ten years. During this period, Stahl led the largest department at the Institute, helped develop an extensive educational program, and consulted on a number of high profile cases including the Vietnam war crimes that inspired the film *Casualties of War*, the deaths of three NASA astronauts at Cape Kennedy, and the assassination of Robert F. Kennedy.

In 1975, Stahl was asked to become the Chairman of the Department of Laboratory Medicine at the Naval Medical Center in Bethesda, Maryland. He was also appointed the Consultant in Pathology to the



Surgeon General, Professor of Pathology at the Uniformed Services University, director of the residency program in anatomic and clinical pathology, and director of the center's program in medical technology. In 1980, he went to Tennessee to become Chief of Laboratory Service for the VA, where he developed a Department of Pathology designed to interface with a medical school. Eventually, he became a full-time medical school professor and assumed duties as the Assistant Chief Medical Examiner for the State of Tennessee. After six years, he became Chief of Staff at the VA hospital at Wright State University in Indiana, where he remained until 1991. That year, Stahl became the Deputy Medical Inspector for the Naval Medical Research Institute until October of 1992, when he returned to the AFIP as the Chief Armed Forces Medical Examiner, where he remained until his retirement.

Series/Scope and Content Note: The collection contains materials donated to the National Museum of Health and Medicine by Dr. Charles J. Stahl. The seven series were developed in collaboration with the assistant archivist and the material is preserved in its original order wherever possible. See OHA 89, Box 001, Folder 00031 for an oral history interview of Stahl, in which he discusses anatomical and clinical pathology, forensic pathology, development of forensic pathology at AFIP, aerospace pathology, AFIP training, Vietnam, forensic military cases, Project Gemini, Robert Kennedy, Old Red Brick, ARP, pathology at the Naval Medical Center, Hal Schumacher, and the AFIP's Medical Examiner's Office.

SERIES 001: OFFICE FILES AND MANUALS

This series includes materials from Dr. Stahl's office files, including magazine and newspaper clippings, reprints, reports, staff directories, protocols, meeting information, subpoenas, and professional and scientific training manuals. Specific subjects of interest include chemical warfare and firearms. In Box 001, Stahl's role in the changing policy landscape is also documented in his work with the Firefighter Autopsy Protocol Advisory Panel and the National Institute of Justice Working Group. Additionally, this box includes documentation for the telephone and verbal conversation records of Dr. Stahl from the period 1992-1996. Contents for the remainder of this series, in Box 001 and Box 002, were originally in binders from training meetings attended by Dr. Stahl from 1966-1990. The subjects of trainings included personnel and executive management, advanced forensic pathology, and the Federal Bureau of Narcotics School.

SERIES 002: PUBLICATIONS AND PROFESSIONAL MATERIAL

This series contains reprinted material published by Dr. Stahl throughout his career (the period from 1951-2002 is represented) as well as programs and copies from a wide range of lectures, seminars, and symposia where Dr. Stahl presented data from his research. Letters of appreciation, information on professional appointments, and notes related to various awards and certificates given to Dr. Stahl are also included. Subjects of professional interest to Dr. Stahl (including geographic pathology, chemical warfare, airships, pistols, presidential assassinations, and the Apollo space program) are labeled in separate files, in the order determined by Dr. Stahl.

SERIES 003: FORENSIC PATHOLOGY AND MEDICAL EXAMINER CASES

This series contains materials from Dr. Stahl's work as a forensic pathologist and medical examiner in the 1960s. During this period, Dr. Stahl was employed as Associate Pathologist with the State of Maryland's Department of Post Mortem Examiners (files cover the period 1962-1963) and then spent time in Guam, as the Chief of Laboratory Services for the U.S. Navy and Deputy Medical Examiner for the island (files cover the period 1963-1965). These files primarily hold autopsy reports and records, with



detailed postmortem examinations and photographs from cases. Some additional clippings related to cases are included. Given the private medical information in these files, access to these records is restricted.

SERIES 004: LEGAL CASE FILES

This series contains material from a wide range of legal cases that Dr. Stahl worked on, in a variety of capacities as forensic pathologist, medical examiner, and consultant. Cases include public and private actions, both civil and criminal. Materials include correspondence, research data, clippings, legal opinions, and decisions, some of which is privileged and restricted. Notable subjects include the controversial prescription drug Vioxx, the death of Deputy White House Counsel Vince Foster, a wrongful death lawsuit involving the Church of Scientology, and a landmark case from the Civil Rights Division. Additionally, Box 004 includes a listing of autopsy protocols for the period 1957-1962.

SERIES 005: SLIDES

This series includes slides taken from a variety of locations and contexts in Dr. Stahl’s career. The original labels have been preserved for the slides wherever possible. The images were taken from postmortem examinations, pathological investigations, field work, crime scenes, and lectures. A wide range of criminal and accidental causes of deaths are portrayed in the series, in addition to specific diseases and conditions. Due to the sensitive nature of many images and privacy provisions, this series is restricted.

SERIES 006: POSTERS AND CERTIFICATES

This series includes dozens of awards and certificates presented to Dr. Stahl throughout his career.
