Research into craniofacial reconstruction surgery has been recently accelerated by the Department of Defense to help Warfighters recover from traumatic battlefield injuries. Such research often directly benefits the civilian population. Join plastic surgeon Eduardo Rodriguez, MD, DDS, of New York University Langone Medical Center to learn about the advancing field of facial reconstruction for individuals with devastating composite facial disfigurement. Rodriguez will discuss innovative technologies used in face transplants, including the combination of computer-assisted planning and intraoperative navigation to provide solutions for previously unpredictable problems.
