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**Biographical Note:** Receipt (recipe) book of Dr. Horace C. Gillette of East Windsor, Connecticut.

**Scope and Content Note:** The notebook consists of handwritten recipes for various medicines, both Gillette's and those attributed to other doctors, along with dosage information. It includes treatments for ailments such as rheumatism, cholera, dropsies, measles, itch, asthma, bilious colic, ringworm, purulent discharge, amenorrhea, hemorrhagia, dysentery, fever, burns, headache, hygiene pills, jaundice, cough, and toothache.
