AUTOPSY DATA SHEET

Material evidence, the anatomical profile compiled by the forensic anthropologist, and trauma analysis may be used to determine a tentative identification and as supporting data for the investigation. In order to make a scientific identification, it is necessary to exclude all other individuals through the scientific analysis of fingerprints, dental records, and DNA. JPAC Central Identification Laboratory (CIL) requires that two of these scientific methods must confirm the identification of the individual in order for the case to be RESOLVED.
